Fanni's Purple Book is the fifth in a series of 10 small book, about the imaginative play of Fanni. Currently nominated for one of the prestigious prizes at the 28. Biennale of Illustrations Bratislava and sold in translation to China Mainland and South Korea.

Inger Tobiasen is one of the best-known Danish illustrators of children's books – with her recognisable style, she catches the sentiments of children beautifully and she has provided artwork for many books, also by other authors.

SYNOPSIS

Fanni's thread is purple. It winds through the house like a maze. Finally, the thread ends in Aunt Lilla's knitting basket. Here Fanni also finds a fine knitted sweater. It fits her perfectly. She wins the thread in a huge spanner and thinks that now Aunt Lilla can knit her a hat and a scarf.
