Elvira Fragola offers serene writing and artwork - a kind of mindfulness for parent and child, so needed in our busy lives.

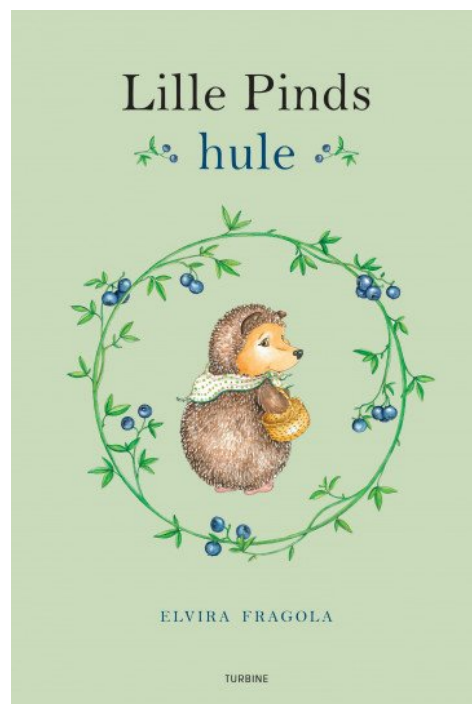
SYNOPSIS
