
# Valhalla - The Land of the Gods

Kenneth Bøgh Andersen is behind a new trilogy of novels, aimed at 9+, based on the beloved Valhalla universe - the bestselling classic comic series from Denmark. The books offer plenty of humour and excitement, as the human children, Tjalfe and Røskva, go on adventures with the roaring Thunder God, Thor, and the rather sneaky, Loki.

Kenneth Bøgh Andersen is a bestselling Danish author of horror, fantasy and sci-fi novels, translated into 15 languages.

Peter Madsen is an award-winning Danish comic book illustrator and one of the ideamakers behind the most successful comic book series Denmark has ever produced.

Mille and Milla are back in top-form with bungee jumping, super soap bubbles and a sausage-eating Basse acting as a happy magician's dog. This is the sixth book in the popular series about two friends with the same name and the same wacky humour.

Anne Sofie Hammer is one of the most popular Danish children's books writers, and author of the bestselling series about Villads from Valby.

Sofie Lind Mesterton is an illustrator and visual storyteller, with a degree from the Royal Danish Art Academy's School for Design.



The school is celebrating its 150th anniversary with a birthday show and a visit from the mayor. The proceeds will go towards new toilets, and Mille and Mille are VERY keen to support this.

They decide to put on a magician's show at the party and their teacher immediately offers to be their glittery assistant. And with so many troublemakers gathered on one stage, the stage is set for lots of fun and frolic.

Meanwhile, Mille's older brother, Jonas, is acting totally strange AGAIN as he enters a new phase of rambunctious puberty, much to the girls' amazement.

Nicole Boyle Rødtnes (born 1985) is a popular Danish children's book and YA writer




How far will you go for your freedom?

### **SYNOPSIS**

In the four books, we get a glimpse into the lives of the four girls - Kioli, Viola, Samantha and Lin - we see their personal development - and we see how their friendship is put to the test. Because the question is if friendship is more important than fame...

Every book is told from the point of view of one of the girls - this is Lin's story:

Pop Sisters have made it through to the talent show Stardust, but Lin has other things on her mind. She's angry at her self-absorbed parents who have just divorced. It's as if the friends in Pop Sisters don't quite understand what Lin is going through. However, the mysterious and rebellious Tina does, and she pulls Lin in a different direction. Lin drifts further away from the girls in Pop Sisters and suddenly finds herself a little too alone ...

A sweet, funny and thought-provoking series for tweens about friendship, identity and courage.

The first book is currently nominated for the Writer's Prize (Skriverprisen) - a prize given by the Danish Children's & Educational Ministry every year.

Venja is firmly determined to find Inge again, even if all other people at the castle pretend that she has never existed. In her search for Inge, Venja chances upon many more mysteries than she could have imagined, but fortunately she receives help from an unexpected direction.

A boy lives alone in a little house. He is mostly on his own. He can no longer remember what his name is - it been too long since anyone said his name. It's possible that there was once a lady living there, who called him Sausage, but he is not quite sure.

One day he gets a letter from the school: the boy has to attend and learn maths and sit still in class. Luckily, he meets the girl, Kirsten, who cannot comprehend why he doesn't have a name.

Maybe they can find a suitable name for him together?

"It is a really lovely and moving book with lots of food for thought and convertion sparks - on e.g. loneliness, gender identity and lack of responsible adults. The few adults in the book are rather caricatured and awful. The teacher is tired of children and bullies Kirsten because she cannot spell; the boy lives alone without any adults around; and it is indicated that Kirsten is being hit at home.
